The Mason City Area Veteran's Monument honoring veterans was dedicated in Central Park by the Mason City Veterans Memorial Association November 11, 2004. Veterans who have ties to the Mason City area and have served honorably with any of the Armed Forces of the United States, are eligible to have their name etched on the monument.

We request a minimum contribution of \$150.00, a completed application, and a copy of proof of honorable discharge (DD214) before we can place the veteran's name on the monument. No contribution is necessary for any veteran killed in action (KIA), missing in action (MIA), or those who were prisoners of war (POW).

The monument consists of 12 black granite stones, with room for 4,600 names. Names shall be continuously accepted for inclusion on the monument. Names received prior to June 30th. of each year will be inscribed prior to Veterans Day (November 11). Names received after June 30th will be inscribed on the monument the next year
